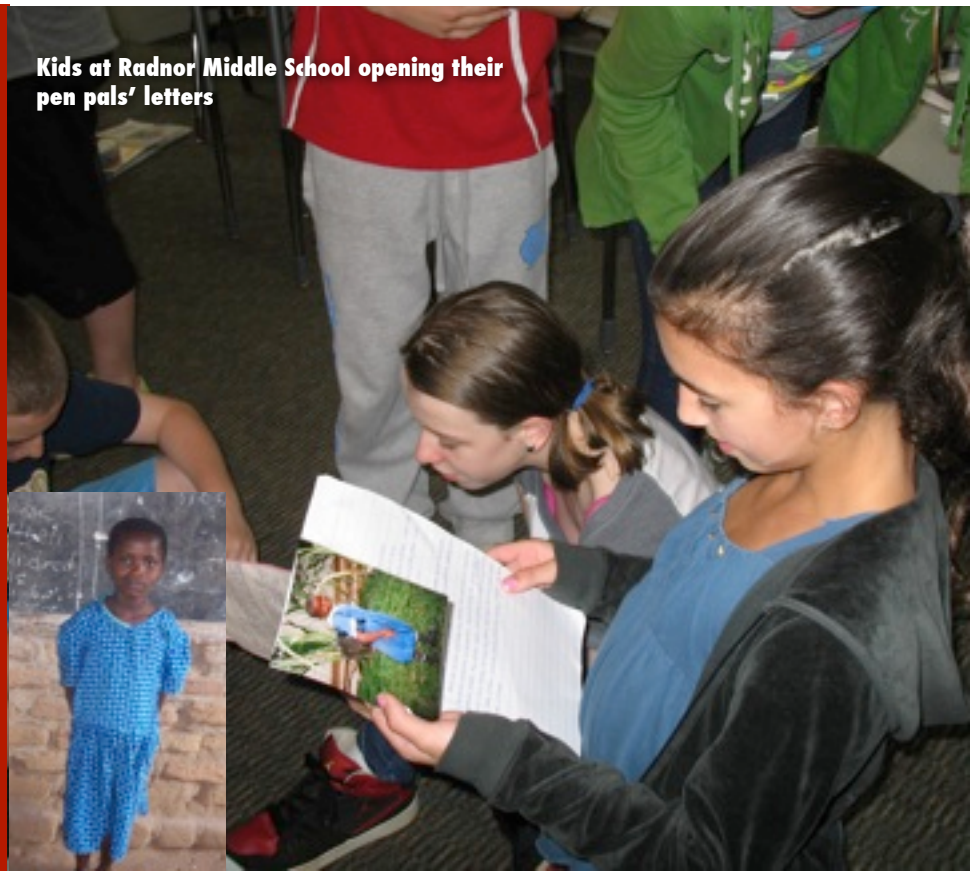

Radnor Middle School has been working with Kuchanga Travel to help build a latrine for Bupala Primary School in the Iganga district of Uganda. The school and community have raised the funds needed to build the new facility. This summer, a group of volunteers is going



to see this project through to its completion. Kuchanga Travel will be taking volunteers to help with the construction, meet the kids and have a great adventure in Uganda!



Reaching out

Nothing empowers youth like making connections with other kids in other parts of the world. For the past several years, students in Jodi Sabra's classes have been corresponding with students in Uganda. They not only learned about a new culture, but they also realized that many of the conveniences that they take for granted in Radnor are luxury items for students in Uganda.

Bupala School has about 1,000 children and only two classrooms. Most of the children attend classes under trees. They all use one latrine that has broken doors. Unfortunately, this lack of privacy is often the reason many young women drop out of school.

The Radnor students agreed that privacy is a basic human right, so they embarked on a mission to raise the funds to build a latrine that would provide the students at Bupala School with the privacy they deserve. Their

efforts led to generous contributions from across the local community that totaled more than \$6,000! Next step: see this project through to its completion.

Good deeds. Good times.

We invite you to join us for an African adventure guaranteed to change lives and create a healthier environment. This journey will combine volunteering with the thrill of exploring the beauty of Africa and the unique opportunity to interact in village life. All participants will be able to help in some way. And – let's get right to it – there's no poop involved in the project. A latrine is a simple building covering a septic pit. Nobody will be using the facilities during construction. The visit will offer great recreation as well, including white water rafting and hiking, a day of urban tourism in Kampala and a four-day wildlife safari!

What to expect

While village life in Uganda is much simpler than life in Radnor, we will be staying in accommodations with running water and delicious food with some western options for those with less adventurous palettes. There will be many opportunities to eat the local food; bottled water and packaged snacks will be provided. We will be traveling in a bus or van while volunteering and four-wheel drive while on safari.

Most people speak some English and you can easily get around with English as everyone who goes to school learns it in school. We will learn the Buganda greeting and some simple phrases once there.

Winston Churchill called Uganda "the pearl of Africa" because of its beauty and natural resources. So come with an open mind, enjoy your surroundings, and most of all, enjoy the warmth and hospitality that Ugandans are famous for!

Itinerary

Day 1: Friday July 27

Kuchanga Travel will meet you at the airport when you arrive and we will be staying overnight in Entebbe as most flights from the US arrive late in the day. After we pick you up from the airport, we'll go to the hotel, relax and eat some dinner or snack, depending on arrival time.

Day 2 : Saturday July 28

Breakfast at the hotel and then on to Bupala village. Enjoy the beautiful scenery along the way. We'll stop for lunch and continue on to the village. We should arrive in the village late in the afternoon. We'll meet and greet the community. We will be staying in nearby Iganga Town in a hotel with running water.

Day 3: Sunday July 29

After breakfast we will head out to Beautiful Sipi Falls for a day of hiking and enjoying the falls.

Day 4 - 8: Monday-Friday, July 30-August 3

These will be days spent helping to build the latrine, side by side with the local Bupala community. We'll be doing some wood construction, roofing, plastering and painting, depending on the pace of the project. We'll also spend some time at Bupala School. Free time before dinner, relax in the evening and enjoy.

Day 9: Saturday August 4

After breakfast we will head to Jinja for a bit of adventure. You can opt to go white water rafting in the beautiful Blue Nile or just enjoy the scenery. There are all levels of rapids and rafting to choose from. Have a bite to eat in one of Jinja's many Indian restaurants. We'll stay overnight in Jinja at the Gately Hotel.

Day 10: Sunday August 5

Some free time in the morning and then we will head to Kampala. We'll see a wonderful dance and music show highlighting the different traditions from all over Uganda. We'll sleep in Kampala at the Speke Hotel.

Day 11: Monday August 6

We'll leave early in the morning and head out for safari. We'll stop over for lunch in the village of Masindi. We'll arrive at Murchison Falls with time for a hike atop the Falls.

Day 12: Tuesday August 7

After breakfast, we'll head into the plains to see lion prides, water buffalo, giraffes, elephants, waterbucks, Uganda kob, the occasional leopard. We'll take a boat cruise up the Nile, view the crocs, hippos & lots of birds and return back to the hotel for a relaxing evening.

Day 13: Wednesday - August 8

After breakfast, we'll head into the plains again to see what we have missed. We'll return back to the hotel for a relaxing evening under the stars.

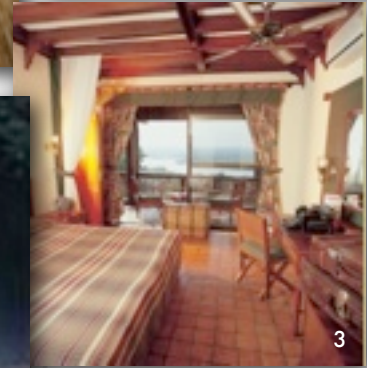
Day 14: Thursday - August 9
